General Rules:

1. For ages: 13 to 113 years old. Prizes awarded for:
 - Best team costumes
 - Best team table decorations
 - 2011 P-Town Showdown 2 Championship TeamRegister your team of four to six people by October 21st.
2. An online Team Registration Form is available at the Library website, <http://lmlibrary.org>. Forms will also be available at the Library. A team is not registered until they have turned in a form with at least four team members on it. Incomplete teams will not be accepted.
3. Doors open at 6:00 pm. Teams must be ready to go at 6:15; contest begins promptly at 6:30 pm.
4. Bring "brain food" and snacks for your own team.
5. Each team should have a name; be fun and creative (name must be library appropriate). Plan on something to identify your team: t-shirts, hats, badges. You can even decorate your table to build team spirit.
6. Teams will compete in five rounds. Questions from each round will be from 10 different categories. The Conductor will start and end each round—when the alarm sounds, the answer sheets must be turned in to Judges immediately.
7. This is a friendly competition, so no outside resource materials or electronic devices may be accessed during the contest. That means cell phones are turned off, please!
8. You will be working together with your teammates to answer the questions so be sure not to say answers too loudly or other teams may hear.
9. Your team will receive a sheet for each round on which to write your answers. Your team name must be marked on your sheets in order for your answers to be graded and recorded.
10. At the end of each round answer sheets will be collected and graded. The questions will be reviewed, the round leaders will be announced, and the next round will begin. After the five rounds are complete, team scores will be totaled and the team with the highest score will be declared the winner.
11. Be as specific as possible in your answers taking into consideration dates and time frames of the questions. All decisions by the judges are final.
12. In the box on your round 1 answer sheet, write your team's guess of the total number of correct answers your team believes it will achieve. In the event of a tie after Round 5, the team that is closest to its guess will be deemed the winner. If this also results in a tie, the team with the most 1st place standings in the rounds will be declared the winner.
